

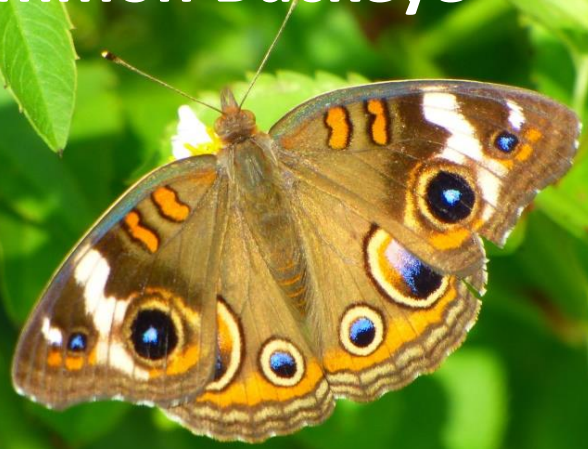
Butterflies of Saint George Plantation

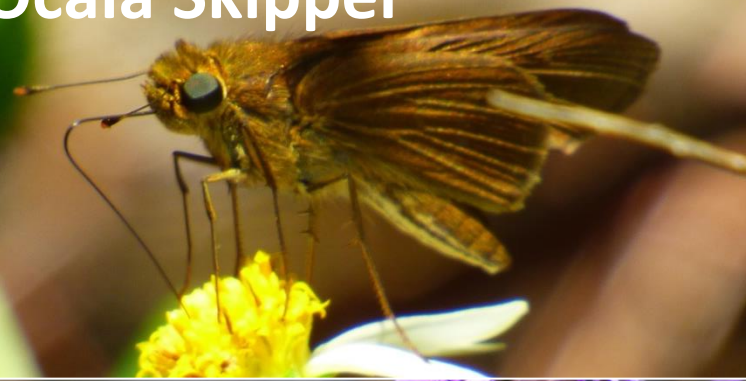

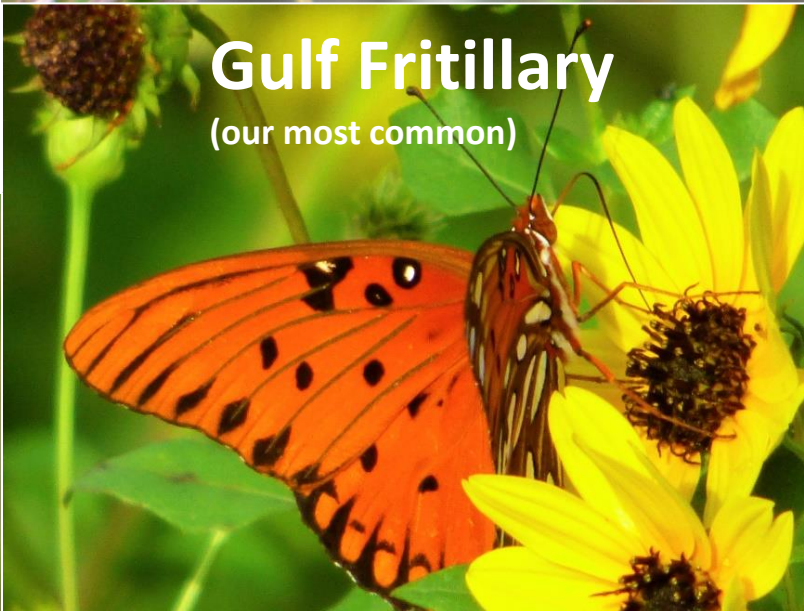
